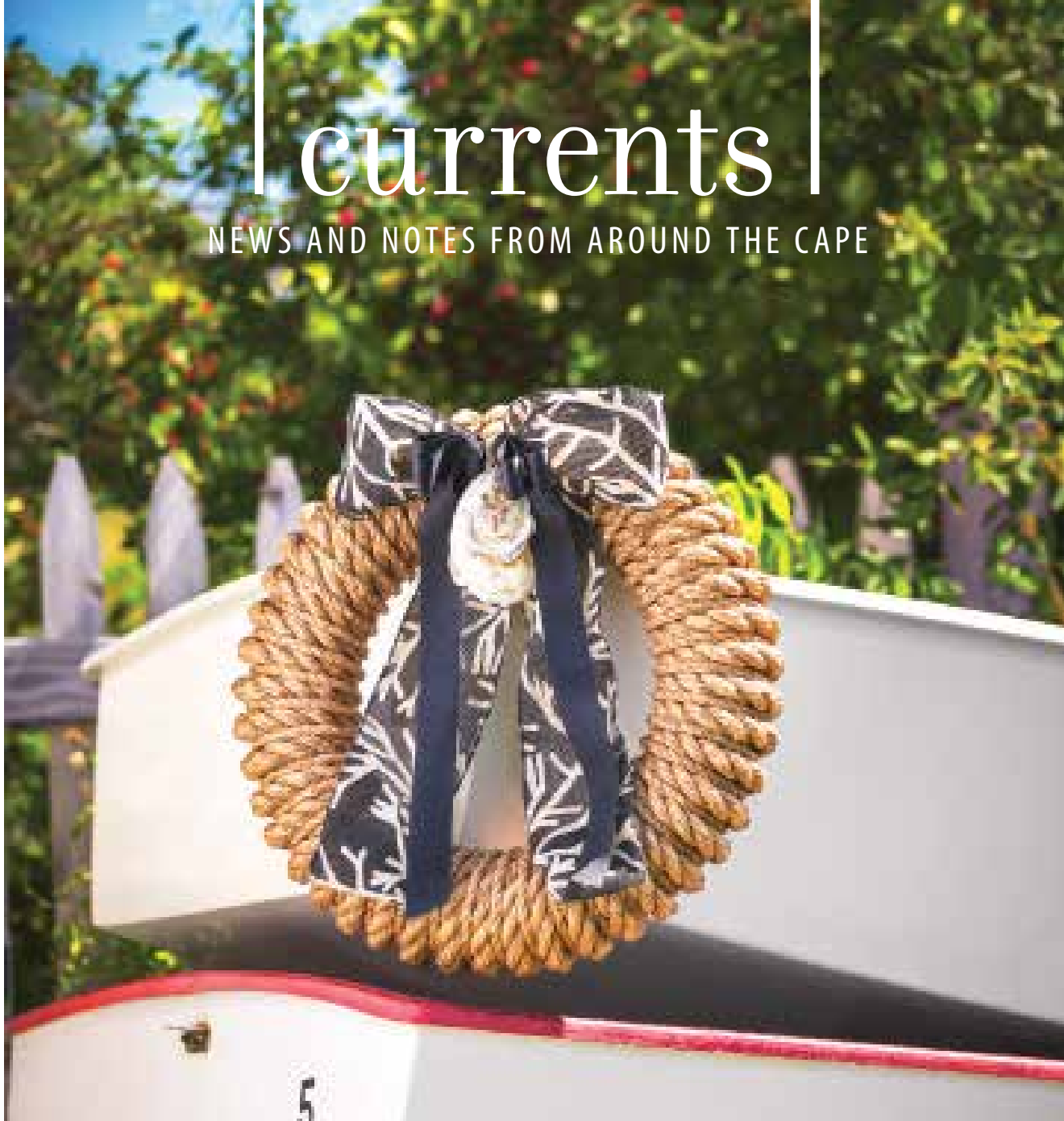

## Nautical Twist

When Jennifer Fallon started making wreaths out of her garage several years ago, she never dreamed her passion would turn into a full-time career. In 2013, the mother of three and certified CPA launched **The Festive Home**, which features interior design services and the Hampton Wreath, the centerpiece of her company. "It's just been wild watching it grow," says Fallon, who says working for start-up companies helped launch her own start-up. The 21-inch diameter wreath is made from high-quality manila and burlap marine roping (more than 70 feet!) and is designed to withstand harsh weather conditions. The best part about the sophisticated and sustainable door decor? Customers can customize their wreaths and switch out the accessories for each season: from sand dollars, starfish, and seashells to greenery, pine cones and harvest grass. The Hampton Wreaths can also be used to make beautiful centerpieces. The wreaths retail for \$99 apiece and accessories range from \$22-\$30.
